The fifth short-term exchange of groups of pupils takes place in Portugal and consists in presenting the modern tale written by each partner country. The Modern tale focuses on European Values and on other modern issues. The topic of the meeting will be "**Fairy-Tale Europe**", meaning that each country should reveal their modern topics in an original manner. .

Detailed programme of the activity:

Objectives:

- presenting creatively the modern tale;
- promoting European values;
- inspiring reflection on tales and values.

Details of the activity:

The final students exchange has as main goal the presentation of the original modern tales in a creative manner. The participants will reunite in order to present their "Fairy-Tale Europe", which is their own vision about Europe and its modern values encrypted in the language of a tale.

After the presentations, each participant team will explain their narrative choices, speaking about the connection between European values and their native cultures.

The students are invited to use different, original techniques to present their stories in an attractive manner: through painting, drawing, acting, singing etc.

Methodological Recommendation:

- Suggesting complex ways of presentation: role-playing, drawing, dancing, images/short films etc;
- Facilitate discussion between the participants on modern tales.
